Tuition Policies

Next month's Tuition will be due September 1st. If you have signed up for our convenient AutoPay, it will be processed that day. Payments are due by the 10th of each month. After the 10th, a \$15 Late Fee will apply. A 30-Day written email notice is required for withdrawing from classes. Final Tuition is due May 1, 2024.

You may make payments and confirm your classes through your account in our Parent Portal or leave check in the studio tuition locked box. If you are sending a payment in with your student, please let them know to put them directly in the tuition box next to the front desk when they enter. We can't even begin to tell you how many checks that get lost in dance bags.

Reminders

- The Dunwoody Police Department and Dunwoody Village Shopping Center do not allow us a true Carpool Line since the road between our entrance and the parking lot is a 2way street. Through the years we have had many a close call with students darting through parked cars along the curb trying to reach their parents, and we want to keep our students safe as possible when they leave our building.
 - It is okay to "pause" to drop off or pick up your student. We ask that you adhere to traffic directions and approach from the Walgreens side of the parking lot. At pick up if you arrive early or do not see your student waiting outside, we ask for you to park and either walk up to our curb to pick up your student or wait until you see them before driving to the curb. We cannot have cars just sitting in a line even with the engine on.
- We will not be allowing any outside people (Parents, Grandparents, Nannies) in the building other than the dancers taking class, teachers, and staff. We have found that with less distractions our dancers are more successful in class, and this also avoids

strangers from wandering into the building putting our dancers at risk. It's also a great chance for you to treat yourself to a break. We keep our younger dancer classes in our downstairs studios so you may watch from our outside windows.

- Bring your change of shoes in your bags and do not plan on changing your outfits between classes. We provide shelving for dance bags, so please make sure they have a small compact bag with only what they need.
- <u>Hip Hop students</u>, you MUST bring a clean pair of sneakers for Hip Hop in your bag. You may not wear your street shoes inside the studio and then into the dance room. We are trying to keep our floors clean for all styles of dance.
- Do not come to class not feeling well (including a slight headache or tummy ache.) We
 encourage you to talk with your children about how they are feeling each day and really
 discuss slight symptoms as they may be the only symptoms they show. We are all
 aware that sometimes there might not be any symptoms at all.
